We Can Shape Our Words

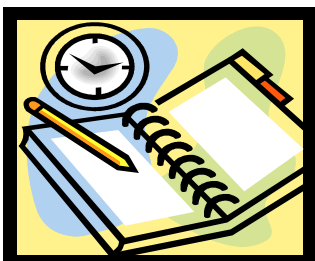
Sometimes our words can be more pointed than necessary. When we speak it would be wise to ensure that those words are spoken in the most palatable manner possible. It is a good habit to pay attention to the words we speak and make an active effort to make sure that our speech is kept as inoffensive as possible.

We Can Weigh Our Words

Sometimes we can find ourselves using words too "heavy" for the situation at hand. We should consider the following. Is this situation as severe as it seems or are we simply upset? Consider the audience. Are you speaking to someone who is easily upset or is already upset? Weighing our words and our reaction before the words actually pass from our lips can circumvent deep hurts that can take years to heal.

It is often said that once a word has passed our lips there is no chance of ever retrieving it. The damage is done and nothing can change that. Many times hurts are inflicted that take weeks, months and even years for healing to come.

We drive our vehicles with full knowledge of what one mistake could cost. The same care should be taken when we speak words to those around us. Let the wisdom of the Spirit of God lead us as we speak to those around us.
