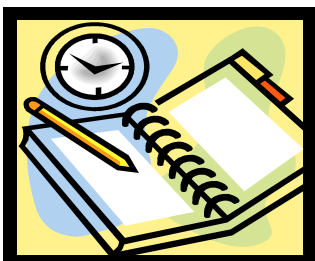
Brother CJ Holmes Jr worked hard to keep services and activities going during the day portions of the Summer Camp Meeting along with the help of Brother
