There will be a surprise door prize but only for the most word savvy.

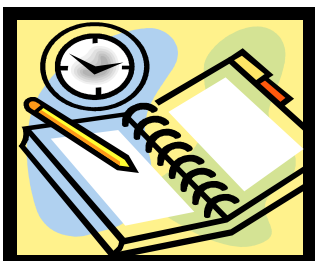
There will be no registration fee to attend but there will be a love offering taken to help defray the costs of the meeting.
