A Letter From Pastor Tony Lay

God is pouring out His Spirit here in New Mexico.

Recently I was invited to preach at a church of a different faith here in Las Cruces. As I taught the doctrine of Oneness, Baptism in Jesus name, the infilling of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in other tongues and the operation of the gifts people began to take hold of this wonderful truth although not all received it.

About a week after I left the church I was asked to return and baptize some of them in Jesus name. I was able to

baptize 10 people right away.

Those same people have now asked that I pastor them and build a work with their help. There are others who want to be baptized in Jesus name as well as soon as I can.

I recently preached a 4 day revival in Moriarty New Mexico where 4 received the Holy Ghost and several were healed. A teenage girl was delivered of demon possession and several remained slain in the spirit throughout the entire service.

My wife, Angela, and I have enjoyed

doing God's work here in New Mexico.

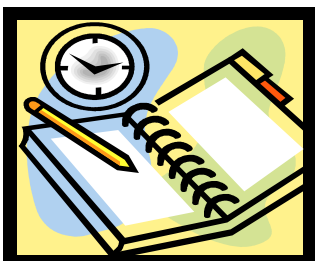
All we are required to do is humble ourselves and preach God's work without fear or favor.

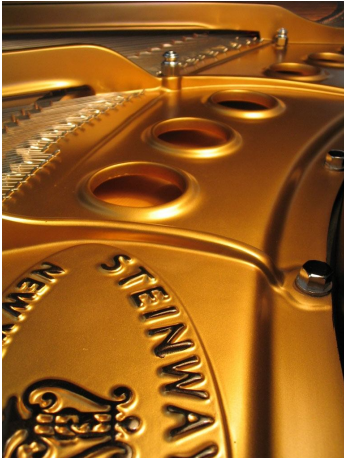
