The Christian And His Worship

John 4:24 *God is a spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.*

The will of man is the regulator which controls his activity and response. The mind can believe. The heart can be touched. But until the will of man submits to God no action or meaningful response will result.

Our worship should be of; "One mind", "Pure minds", "Sound minds", and a "Willing Mind".

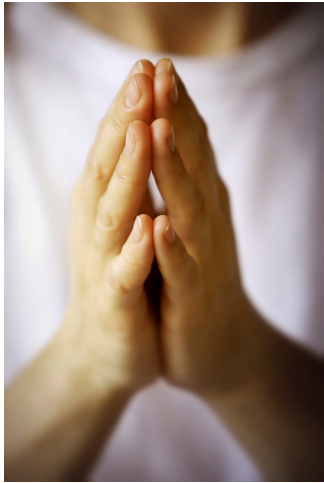
As we are convinced in our minds and concentrate our thoughts in praise and adoration unto Him anything can result from our worship.

This high electricity bill is dwindling away our funds and it would simply be an unwise use of the funds you have donated to continue to pay nearly \$5000 per year for electricity.

This was discussed at Mid-Winter Conference and it was decided that the best option would be to purchase a generator that would carry

the electrical load of the camp ground facility.

After a diligent search for the right equipment at a fair price we have located a 100kw generator etc for a total price of \$6500.
